We are a licensed, part-time preschool for infants through Pre-K children three days a week: Monday, Wednesday, and Friday, 9am-2pm. We also offer Late Care from 2pm to 4pm. Teacher work hours are 8:30am to 2:30pm, with the option to work Early Care at 7:45am and Late Care until 3pm or 4pm. Our school year runs from mid-August through late May.
